EXPANDER FOR OBERHEIM DX DRUM MACHINES

The DX Drum Machine continues to set the standard for the most cost-effective professional drum machine you can buy. Why? It's because the DX's separate-chip design lets you select each sound according to your own needs. This design costs a little more, but Oberheim knows that the professional musician needs the flexibility and fresh sound that only individual chips can provide.

Professional musicians also want to use more sounds at the same time. That's why we've developed the DX Stretch, part of a new unique drum family from Oberheim.

Stretch adds the two things DX owners want most of all: more sounds and more features. Four more voices, plus new features for older machines. Features like variable clock, auto-start, and non-stop mode changes, that make it easier and faster to use in any situation.

Stretch?

Stretch is an add on unit for any DX Drum Machine, new or old. Stretch connects to the left side of the DX, and the combined unit appears... *S t r e t c h e d*.

Each Stretch voice has its own buttons, tuning control, output jack, and level control for the Mixed Output of the DX.

Adding Stretch to a DX without MIDI also adds all of the Software features of the MIDI DX, such as Punch-Out/Punch-In, Variable Clock Rates (24-48-96), Selective Tape Loading (DMX Compatible), Auto-Start, Programmable Metronome, Cue Tempo, High-Resolution Step Mode, etc.

In addition, MIDI Clock Out is included, to enable synchronization with other sequencers and drum machines via MIDI.

Stretch voices function in the same way as the other voices, and can be recorded and played as part of the DX's memory.

Everything that can be done with a DX voice can be done with a Stretch voice, including assignable trigger & click, and voice muting.

Stretch comes with quick change "ZIF" sockets ready for your choice of sounds. Oberheim has a new single chip voice library of sounds for Stretch and the DX.

In addition to Oberheim's continually expanding sound library, other companies offer additional sounds. And our forthcoming* Digital MIDI Sampler / EPROM Programmer will let you create your own sounds and program your own sound chips, opening the door to a new world of creativity.

How do you Stretch a DX?



